The second advanced course in the study of American Sign Language (ASL). The course focuses on receptive and productive mastery of syntax, spatial mapping, narrative and explanatory discourse, targeted vocabulary and incorporation into sign production the necessary adjustments for register, affect and cultural background.

Discourse Competence

Master nuances of ASL sign vocabulary.

Assessment Method: Locally developed exams

Performance Criteria:

Students must perform at 80% or better accuracy, receptively and productively, all basic ASL vocabulary items

Deaf Culture Knowledge

Articulate the norms and values of the Deaf culture.

Assessment Method: Locally developed exams

Performance Criteria:

Students must earn a 80% or better on an exam which tests students' knowledge of Deaf culture norms and their relevance to interpreting and Deaf interaction

Fingerspelling Mastery

Attain mastery level receptive and productive fingerspelling skills.

Assessment Method: Locally developed exams

Performance Criteria:

Students must earn a 80% or better on performance exam that includes receptive and productive fingerspelling tasks
