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### Course Description:

Scientific principles of dental hygiene practice with emphasis on preventive dental health concepts, promotion of dental health, exposure control, data collection, patient assessment, oral health education and basic dental hygiene instrumentation. Two classroom, six lab hours per week.

#### Exposure Control Management

Describe the various bloodborne and airborne pathogens and strategies to reduce occupational exposure in the dental office setting as required by the OSHA standard.

Describe basic preventive techniques incorporated in all patient care plans to establish a good oral health routine.

Describe the various indices used in collecting data and the techniques for assessing patient periodontal health.

**Assessment Method:** Locally developed exams

**Performance Criteria:** 70% or higher on examination

#### Oral Health Education & Disease Prevention

Describe the basic principles of oral health education in the development of individualized patient care plans.

**Assessment Method:** Locally developed exams

**Performance Criteria:** 70% or higher on examination

**Performance Criteria:** 80% or higher on patient education brochures
