Course Description:

This is the introductory laboratory experience within the paramedic program. Skills will be reviewed and retested from the Emergency Medical Technician level. CPR will be retested. New skills will involve patient assessment, airway management and pharmacology, including drug math. Four lab hours per week.

Assessment Method: Simulations

Performance Criteria: During simulated patient encounters, 100% of the successful students will demonstrate paramedic level patient assessment skills without violating critical criteria.

Airway

Demonstrate the assessment and techniques related to airway/ventilation management.

Assessment Method: Simulations

Performance Criteria: During simulated patient encounters, 100% of the successful students will demonstrate paramedic level airway/ventilation management techniques without violating critical criteria.

Pharmacology

Demonstrate the techniques of gaining vascular access and the administration of medications.

Assessment Method: Simulations

Performance Criteria: During simulated patient encounters, 100% of the successful students will demonstrate paramedic level vascular access and medication administration techniques without violating critical criteria.
