#### Course Description:

This course reviews all materials from the entire paramedic program. Its goals are to integrate past knowledge and skills into a comprehensive approach to out-of-hospital patient care. Four classroom hours per week for eight weeks.

#### Course Outcomes:

##### Comprehensive Subsection

Demonstrate appropriate management of cardiac, medical, trauma, airway/respiratory patients and EMS operation issues within written simulated patient presentations.

**Assessment Method:** Locally developed exams

**Performance Criteria:** On a comprehensive examination, created by the EMS department, covering all material from the entire paramedic program, 100% of the successful students will score at least a 63% on each of 5 sections of a written examination covering the management of out of hospital patients.

##### Comprehensive Overall

Demonstrate the overall mastery of the knowledge gained throughout the paramedic program on the management of cardiac, medical, trauma, airway/respiratory patients and EMS operation issues within written simulated patient presentations.

**Assessment Method:** Locally developed exams

**Performance Criteria:** On a comprehensive examination, created by the EMS department, covering all material from the entire paramedic program, 100% of the successful students will score at least a 70% overall on a written examination covering the management of out of hospital patients.

##### External Validity

Demonstrate the overall mastery of knowledge gained throughout the paramedic program on the management of cardiac, medical, trauma, airway/respiratory patients and EMS operation issues within written simulated patient presentations created by the Ohio Division of EMS testing agency.

**Assessment Method:** Standardized national examinations

**Performance Criteria:** On a comprehensive examination, created by the Ohio Division of EMS testing agency, at least a 85% of all paramedic graduates will successfully pass the certification examination within 6 attempts.
