Course Description:

This course reviews all materials from the entire paramedic program. Its goals are to integrate past knowledge and skills into a comprehensive approach to out-of-hospital patient care. Four classroom hours per week for eight weeks.

Course Outcomes:

Comprehensive Subsection

Demonstrate appropriate management of cardiac, medical, trauma, airway/respiratory patients and EMS operation issues within written simulated patient presentations.

Assessment Method: Locally developed exams

Performance Criteria: On a comprehensive examination, created by the EMS department, covering all material from the entire paramedic program, 100% of the successful students will score at least a 63% on each of 5 sections of a written examination covering the management of out of hospital patients.

Comprehensive Overall

Demonstrate the overall mastery of the knowledge gained throughout the paramedic program on the management of cardiac, medical, trauma, airway/respiratory patients and EMS operation issues within written simulated patient presentations.

Assessment Method: Locally developed exams

Performance Criteria: On a comprehensive examination, created by the EMS department, covering all material from the entire paramedic program, 100% of the successful students will score at least a 70% overall on a written examination covering the management of out of hospital patients.

External Validity

Demonstrate the overall mastery of knowledge gained throughout the paramedic program on the management of cardiac, medical, trauma, airway/respiratory patients and EMS operation issues within written simulated patient presentations created by the Ohio Division of EMS testing agency.

Assessment Method: Standardized national examinations

Performance Criteria: On a comprehensive examination, created by the Ohio Division of EMS testing agency, at least a 85% of all paramedic graduates will successfully pass the certification examination within 6 attempts.
