Course Description:

This course will review all psychomotor skills covered within the paramedic program as students are prepared for the comprehensive practical examination. Students will also have applied knowledge evaluated within the field setting. Students will discuss appropriate patient care with the medical director of the EMS program. Four lab hours per week for eight weeks.

Demonstrate the appropriate care for out-of-hospital patients during simulated patient encounters.

Assessment Method: Simulations

Performance Criteria: Using grading matrices created by the EMS department, during simulated patient encounters, 100% of the successful students will demonstrate "graduate paramedic level management" of the out-of-hospital patient without violating any critical criteria.

Medical Director Evaluation

Demonstrate the appropriate care for out-of-hospital patients during a review with the physician medical director of the EMS program.

Assessment Method: Simulations

Performance Criteria: Using grading matrices created by the EMS department, during simulated patient encounters created by the medical director, 100% of the successful students will demonstrate "graduate paramedic level management" of the out-of-hospital patient without violating any critical criteria.

Field Evaluation

Demonstrate the appropriate care for out-of-hospital patients within the field setting.

Assessment Method: Simulations

Performance Criteria: Using grading matrices created by the EMS department, during actual patient encounters on ambulances, 100% of the successful students will demonstrate "graduate paramedic level management" of the out-of-hospital patient without violating any critical criteria.
