Course Description:

Discussion of directed practice experience, preparation for the American Association of Medical Assistants (AAMA) National Certification Examination through student presentations, mock exam, skills practicals and discussion topics relative to the medical assisting profession. Students will, as part of this course, prepare to sit for the national credentialing certificate, Certified Medical Assistant (American Association of Medical Assistants). Three lab hours per week.
