Course Description:

First of two field experiences in human service delivery. Professional documentation and refinement of interviewing skills. Pharmacology in behavioral health. Three classroom, fourteen practicum hours per week.

Pharmacology

Identify psychiatric medications and their uses in the behavioral health field and identify available informational resources about psychiatric medication.

Assessment Method: Portfolios

Performance Criteria: 70% or better on written assignments

Clinical Documentation

Prepare written clinical documents: intake, psychosocial database, mental status, treatment plan, and progress note.

Assessment Method: Portfolios

Performance Criteria: 70% or better on all assignments

Cultural Diversity

Demonstrate an awareness and valuing of students' and others' cultural diversity factors.

Assessment Method: Performance appraisals

Performance Criteria: 70% or better on classroom presentation

Assessment Method: Written surveys and/or questionnaires

Performance Criteria: 70% or better on written assignment

Therapeutic Relationships

Establish and maintain effective therapeutic relationships with clients.

Assessment Method: Performance appraisals

Performance Criteria: 70% or better on final evaluation

Professional Work Skills

Under supervision, demonstrate professional and ethical work skills with an interdisciplinary team in an agency setting.

Assessment Method: Performance appraisals

Performance Criteria: 70% or better in class and agency attendance, participation, cooperation and effort . Agency supervisor feedback.

Interviewing Skills

Demonstrate competency in basic interviewing skills.

Assessment Method: Simulations

Performance Criteria: 70% or better in recorded interview and critique
