**Assessment Method:** Performance appraisals

Develop and articulate suitable career objectives and action steps linked to career-specific academic coursework.

**Assessment Method:** Locally developed exams

**Performance Criteria:**

Students must timely complete all assignments, meeting stated written and oral requirements at a performance rate of 60% or higher.

#### On-the-job evaluation

Satisfactory performance on the job as evaluated by a worksite supervisor.

**Assessment Method:** Exit and other interviews

**Performance Criteria:**

Students must achieve 60% or higher based upon employer-based grading rubric.
